AN ACT REGULATING THE SALE OF NON-ALCOHOLIC BEER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 16D the following section:—

3 Section 16E. No person shall sell or offer for sale non-alco-
4 holic beer, so-called, unless he holds a valid license or permit
5 issued under the provisions of this chapter. Whoever makes a sale
6 or delivery of such non-alcoholic beer to any person under eigh-
7 teen years of age for his own use or the use of any other person
8 shall be punished by a fine of not more than two thousand dollars
9 or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both.
