AN ACT MAKING A CORRECTIVE CHANGE IN THE COURT REORGANIZATION BILL, SO-CALLED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Clause fifty-sixth of section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws,  
2 as most recently amended by chapter 478 of the acts of 1978, is  
3 hereby further amended by striking out said clause and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following clause:—

5 Fifty-sixth, "district court" or "municipal court" shall mean a  
6 division of the district court department of the trial court or a  
7 session thereof for holding court. Said words shall include the  
8 Boston municipal court department or a session thereof for hold-  
9 ing court, unless the context clearly intends something to the  
10 contrary.
