AN ACT RELATIVE TO SCHOOL BUILDING AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 SECTION 1. Section 3: of Chapter 70b is hereby amended by striking "Section 9A, 45, 46C of chapter 30,
3 chapter 31 and chapter 150E shall not apply to the executive director or any other employees of the authority."

4 SECTION 2. Said Section 3, of Chapter 70b is further amended by inserting the following language, "All
5 employees of the authority formerly known as the department of education school building assistance program shall
6 retain their jobs under the newly created Massachusetts School Building Authority without impairment of wages,
7 seniority, collective bargaining, civil service or other rights enjoyed prior to the creation of the Massachusetts
8 School Building Authority. Nothing in this section shall prohibit any reduction in workforce otherwise permitted
9 under collective bargaining agreements or civil service rules or regulations."
