### AN ACT REMOVING THE FIFTY MILE RESTRICTION ON USE OF FARM VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The second sentence of section 5 of chapter 90 of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 1198 of the acts of  
3 1973, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 15, 16, 17 and 18,  
4 the words "except those used in the regular delivery substantially  
5 on a daily schedule for sale of farm products or the delivery of  
6 flowers or for distances in excess of a radius of fifty miles from  
7 the farm" and inserting in place thereof the following words: —  
8 used in the regular delivery substantially on a daily schedule for  
9 sale of farm products or the delivery of flowers.
