## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

### AN ACT ALLOWING CERTAIN RETAIL SALES ON ALL SUNDAYS PRECEDING A LEGAL HOLIDAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Clause (50) of section 6 of chapter 136 of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in chapter 722 of the acts of 1977, is hereby amended by
- 3 striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the
- 4 following sentence: — The keeping open of a store or shop and the
- 5 sale at retail of goods therein, but not including the retail sale of
- 6 goods subject to chapter one hundred and thirty-eight, and the
- 7 performance of labor, business, and work connected therewith on
- 8 those Sundays following the fourth Thursday in November and
- 9 preceding Christmas and the Sunday preceding all legal holidays.
