AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL BOARD IN EACH COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 34 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 14 the following section: —

3 *Section 14A.* There shall be in each county a board, to be
4 known as the environmental control board, to consist of five
5 members to be appointed for terms of three years by the
6 county commissioners. Each member of said board shall be
7 paid the sum of one thousand dollars per year. Said board shall
8 conduct studies for and render advice to the county commis-
9 sioners with respect to sound environmental planning and shall
10 investigate the causes and circumstances of all cases of pollu-
11 tion.
