RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY RELATIVE TO PURCHASING IN THE COUNTY AND THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A CENTRAL PURCHASING SYSTEM.

1 *Resolved*, That the county commissioners of Middlesex county
2 are hereby authorized and directed to make an investigation
3 and study relative to present purchasing practices in the county
4 with particular reference to the feasibility of establishing a
5 central purchasing system. For the purpose of retaining the
6 services of a management consultant firm, the commission is
7 authorized to expend no more than twenty thousand dollars.
8 Said commissioners shall report to the general court the results
9 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
10 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such rec-
11 ommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of
12 the house of representatives on or before the fourth Wednesday
13 of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.
