RESOLVE

Relative to improving the Present Method of lighting, heating and ventilating the State House and operating the Elevators therein.

1 *Resolved*, That the state house commission, provided for
2 by section seventeen of chapter ten of the Revised Laws, is
3 hereby authorized and directed to investigate the existing
4 method of lighting, heating and ventilating the state house
5 and of operating the elevators therein, and the probable
6 cost of substituting modern methods therefor. The com-
7 mission shall report the result of its investigations to the
8 general court not later than the tenth day of January,
9 nineteen hundred and twelve, with such recommendations
10 as the commission may deem advisable.

11 For the purposes of this resolve there shall be allowed
12 and paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth a sum
13 not exceeding five hundred dollars.
