AN ACT REQUIRING WRITTEN PERMISSION OF A LOCAL BOARD OF HEALTH PRIOR TO SERVING A HEALTH OR SANITARY NOTICE BY POLICE BETWEEN HOURS OF 6:00 IN THE EVENING AND 8:00 IN THE MORNING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law
2 to the contrary, no police officer shall serve a health or sani-
3 tary notice between the hours of six o'clock postmeridian
4 and eight o'clock antemeridian without written permission
5 from the local board of health.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance
2 by the local city or town.
