AN ACT PLACING THE INCUMBENT OF THE POSITION OF
LABOR MANAGEMENT AGENT OF THE PORT OF BOSTON
AUTHORITY UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS AND RULES.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would
2 tend to defeat its purpose, which is in part to provide
3 forthwith unlimited tenure of employment for the
4 incumbent of the position specified therein, therefore
5 it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, neces-
6 sary for the immediate preservation of the public
7 convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The incumbent of the position of labor manage-
2 ment agent of the Port of Boston Authority on the
3 effective date of this act shall, upon passing a quali-
4 fying examination to which he shall be subjected by
5 the division of civil service, continue to serve in said
6 position subject to the civil service laws and rules,
7 and his tenure of office shall be unlimited, subject,
8 however, to said laws and rules. Upon passing said
9 examination, he shall be deemed to be permanently
10 appointed to said position without being required to
11 serve any probationary period.
