AN ACT RELATIVE TO ENHANCED 911 SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (d) of section 14A of chapter 166 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in the 1996 Official Edition, is hereby
3 amended by adding the following paragraph:—

4 When discontinuing telephone service of a subscriber for
5 failure to pay for such service, or discontinuing such service upon
6 the voluntary request of such subscriber, a telephone company
7 shall not discontinue such subscriber's access to the enhanced 911
8 service. The statewide emergency telecommunication board shall
9 promulgate regulations necessary to carry out the provisions of
10 this paragraph.
