Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT

For the Regulation of the Fisheries in the Town of Winchester.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The provisions of the act passed on the
2 sixteenth day of February, in the year of our Lord
3 one thousand seven hundred and eighty-nine, entitled
4 “ An act to prevent the destruction of the fish called
5 shad and alewives in Mystick River, so called, within
6 the towns of Cambridge, Charlestown and Medford,

7 and for repealing all laws heretofore made for the
8 purpose." And also the provisions of the act passed
9 on the second day of February, in the year of our
10 Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen, entitled
11 "An act for the regulation of the fishery in Woburn,"
12 shall extend to the town of Winchester, in the coun-
13 ty of Middlesex, and to all the streams therein run-
14 ning from any of the ponds or other waters there into
15 Mystick Pond, so called.

1 SECT. 2. "The Committee for the preservation of
2 Fish" in the town of Winchester, may be elected
3 either in the month of March or April, annually, and
4 they shall be invested with all the powers and author-
5 ity conferred by the acts aforesaid on the committees
6 of the several towns therein mentioned.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
