AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY TO PAY A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY ANNUALLY TO THE CITY OF CHELSEA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Massachusetts Port Authority is hereby authorized
2 and directed to pay to the city of Chelsea, the sum of two
3 hundred and fifty thousand dollars annually to compensate
4 said city for the loss of real estate tax income which resulted
5 from taking of land for the construction of the Mystic River
6 bridge in said city.
