## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE INSPECTOR GENERAL TO ESTABLISH A "CITIZEN HOT LINE."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law  
2 to the contrary, the inspector general shall install in his office,  
3 subject to appropriation, a so-called "citizen hot line" which for  
4 the purposes of this act shall be deferred as a toll free telephone  
5 line established for the purpose of receiving telephone calls from  
6 persons who want to give information relating to fraud or waste  
7 in government.
