3 of 1978 is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence
4 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — At
5 the expense of the Commonwealth all jurors shall receive for
6 travel out and home for each day of actual attendance a per
7 mile allowance equal to said allowance received by state em-
8 ployees, but not for such time as the jury is held under re-
9 straint, by order of the court.
