AN ACT RELATIVE TO HOURS OF EMPLOYMENT OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Sections 30A and 30B of chapter 149 of the General Laws
- 2 are hereby amended by striking out the words "metropolitan
- 3 district police" wherever they appear in said sections.
