AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE AWARD OF CONTRACTS IN EMERGENCIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first sentence of paragraph (d) of section 39M of  
2 chapter 30 of the General Laws, inserted by section 1 of  
3 chapter 842 of the acts of 1963, is hereby amended by  
4 adding after the word "twenty-nine", in line 11, the words:  
5 —or, in the case of a county, city, town, district or other  
6 public body, to any contract certified by the awarding  
7 authority, with the approval of the commissioner of labor and  
8 industries, as necessary because of a special emergency  
9 involving the health or safety of the people or their  
10 property.
