By Mr. Carroll of Lynn, petition of the Massachusetts Police Association and another for establishing a salary differential for police officers who are required to work at night. Public Service.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Nine.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A SALARY DIFFERENTIAL FOR POLICE OFFICERS  
WHO ARE REQUIRED TO WORK AT NIGHT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general  
2 or special law to the contrary, regular police officers of every  
3 city or town required to render services between the hours of six  
4 postmeridian and six antemeridian shall be compensated by a  
5 salary increase equal to ten per cent of the hourly rate of their  
6 regular compensation; provided, however, that such increase  
7 shall not become a permanent part of the salary of said police  
8 officers and shall only be paid for those hours actually worked  
9 between the hours of six postmeridian and six antemeridian.  
10 The compensation payable to any police officer shall not be  
11 reduced by reason of the acceptance of this section.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect in a city having a  
2 plan E or plan D charter when accepted by a majority vote of  
3 the city council, and in other cities by vote of the city council  
4 subject to the provisions of its charter, and in a town by vote  
5 of the town at an annual town meeting.
