AN ACT DIRECTING THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF NEED TO LAWRENCE E. WARNER AND CATHERINE E. WARNER.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat
2 its purpose, which is to provide necessary health care services in a
3 certain area of the commonwealth, therefore, it is hereby declared
4 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
5 of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter seven hundred and
2 seventy-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-two or any
3 other contrary provisions of law, the department of public health is
4 hereby authorized and directed to issue a certificate of need to
5 Lawrence E. Warner and Catherine E. Warner and an appropriate
6 nursing home license to Lawrence E. Warner and Catherine E.
7 Warner to authorize the construction and operation of a one
8 hundred and fifty-one bed long term care facility consisting of forty
9 level II and sixty Level III beds with the existing fifty-one bed Level
10 III facility converted to a Level IV facility. The estimated capital
11 expenditure for the project is one million six hundred thousand
12 dollars.
