AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO TRANSFER CERTAIN LAND LOCATED IN BOSTON TO THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION AND PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A LITTLE LEAGUE BALL FIELD ON SAID PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public health is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to transfer to the metropolitan district
3 commission the following parcel of land located in the Forest
4 Hill section of the city of Boston:—

5 Beginning at a point at the intersection of the northerly side
6 of Arborway and the easterly side of South street; thence run-
7 ning in a northerly direction along the easterly side of said
8 South street three hundred feet to a point; thence turning and
9 running in an easterly direction on a line parallel to the north-
10 erly side of Arborway, three hundred feet to a point; thence
11 turning and running on a line parallel to the easterly side of
12 South street three hundred feet, more or less to the northerly
13 side of Arborway; thence turning and running in a westerly
14 direction along the northerly side of said Arborway to the
15 point of beginning.

1 SECTION 2. The metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to construct and maintain a little
3 league ball field on the parcel of land described in section one
4 of this act. For the purposes of this act the department may
5 expend such sums as may be appropriated.
