AN ACT RELATIVE TO CLASSIFICATIONS OF AUTOMOBILE RISKS AND CHARGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 113B of Chap-
2 ter 175, as most recently amended by Chapter 479 of the Acts
3 of 1989, is hereby amended by adding to the ninth sentence the
4 following: — “, provided, however, no classification of risks and
5 premium charges shall be based on geographical or territorial
6 criteria.”

1 SECTION 2. The fifth paragraph of said section 113B is
2 hereby amended by striking the words “sex or marital status” and
3 inserting in their place the following: — “sex, marital status,
4 geographic or territorial criteria”.

1 SECTION 3. The provisions of sections one and two of this
2 act shall apply to classifications of risks and premium charges for
3 policies and bonds issued to become effective January first,
4 nineteen hundred and ninety-two and thereafter.
