AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN CREDITABLE SERVICE TO ANNA K. LOUGHLIN UNDER THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Anna K. Loughlin, a member of the teachers' retirement
2 system, shall be entitled to count as creditable service in said
3 system the periods during which she was employed as a play-
4 ground supervisor by the town of Milton in the years from
5 nineteen hundred and thirty-four to nineteen hundred and
6 forty-five, inclusive, provided that said Anna K. Loughlin shall
7 deposit in the annuity savings fund of said system such amount
8 as the teachers' retirement board shall determine.
