## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

### AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SENIOR CITIZENS TRANSPORTATION IN THE CITIES AND TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, any  
2 city or town which accepts this section is authorized to appropriate  
3 an amount not to exceed \$25,000 annually for the purpose of  
4 establishing a transportation program for senior citizens. Such  
5 program to include transportation for health purposes, for hospital  
6 purposes and such amounts of money as expended by the cities and  
7 towns shall be reimbursed by the commonwealth.
