

HOUSE No. 598

By Mr. Soble of Boston, petition of Frank J. Judah and others for investigation by a special commission of the advisability of developing a portion of the shore of Lake Massapoag in Sharon for park and beach purposes. Harbors and Public Lands.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

Resolve providing for an Investigation by a Special Commission relative to the Advisability of Developing a Portion of the Land surrounding Lake Massapoag in the Town of Sharon for Park and Beach Purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, con-
2 sisting of the commissioner of conservation and four
3 citizens of the commonwealth to be appointed by the
4 governor, is hereby established and is hereby author-
5 ized and directed to investigate the advisability,
6 desirability and cost of acquiring land and developing,
7 and the cost of thereafter maintaining, lands sur-
8 rounding Lake Massapoag in the town of Sharon for
9 park and beach purposes, including adequate facilities
10 for the parking of motor vehicles. Said commission
11 may hold hearings at Boston or Sharon, may require
12 the attendance and testimony of witnesses and the
13 production of books and papers, and may administer
14 oaths to witnesses appearing before it. Said commis-
15 sion shall report to the general court the results of its

16 investigation and its recommendations, if any, to-
17 gether with a draft of legislation to carry the same
18 into effect by filing the same with the clerk of the
19 house of representatives on or before April first in
20 the current year.
