AN ACT ENABLING CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS TO HUNT AND KILL ANTERLESS DEER WITHOUT A SPECIAL PERMIT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Any licensed hunter, sixty-five years of age or older, shall be
- 2 allowed to hunt and kill antlerless deer without applying for a
- 3 special permit from the director.
