AN ACT EXTENDING FURTHER THE DURATION OF A LAW PROVIDING FOR THE TRIAL OR DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN CRIMINAL CASES BY DISTRICT COURT JUDGES SITTING IN THE SUPERIOR COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter four hundred and sixty-nine of the acts of
2 nineteen hundred and twenty-three, as most recently
3 amended by chapter three hundred and fifty-eight
4 of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-seven,
5 is hereby further amended by striking out section
6 five and inserting in place thereof the following: —

7 *Section 5.* This act shall not be operative after
8 December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and forty-
9 one.
