AN ACT REQUIRING LIFE INSURANCE COMPANIES TO PAY
RENEWAL COMMISSIONS TO AGENTS WHO HAVE CEASED
TO BE IN THEIR EMPLOYMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provisions of law, all life
2 insurance companies selling "ordinary insurance",
3 so called, shall pay renewal commissions to agents
4 who have been discharged or have voluntarily ceased
5 to be in their employ, provided all just claims of the
6 company have been met.
