AN ACT RESCINDING BY THE CITY OF REVERE OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE GENERAL LAWS RELATIVE TO PENSIONS FOR POLICEMEN AND FIREFIGHTERS AND THEIR WIDOWS UNDER THE NON-CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAW.
