## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT ELIMINATING THE REQUIREMENT THAT ALL PREMIUM TRANSACTIONS IN AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE BE ON A PRO RATA BASIS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first paragraph of section 113B of chapter 175 of the  
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the second  
3 and third sentences, as appearing in chapter 366 of the acts of  
4 1972, which read as follows: — “In fixing and establishing  
5 premium charges in accordance with the provisions of this  
6 section, the commissioner shall require that all premium  
7 charges shall be based on the actual number of days in a  
8 calendar year during which there was coverage on policies  
9 which are in existence for less than a full calendar year, except  
10 in cases where such a policy is cancelled at the request of the  
11 insured.”
