### AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN ENTITIES FROM THE WORKMENS' COMPENSATION LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 152 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in  
3 line 100, after the word "employer" the first time it appears, the  
4 following:— provided further that any entity that is fifty percent  
5 or more employee owned, with less than four employees, shall not  
6 be deemed to be an employer.
