### RESOLVE RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF MARJORIE M. MURPHY.

1 *Resolved*, That Marjorie M. Murphy, employed by  
2 the commonwealth for twenty-three years and sepa-  
3 rated from the service in the Boston state hospital on  
4 June eighth, nineteen hundred and forty-three, may  
5 be reinstated by the department of mental health for  
6 the sole purpose of being retired.

7 Upon such reinstatement, said Marjorie M. Murphy  
8 shall redeposit in the annuity savings fund of the  
9 state retirement system, within ninety days from the  
10 effective date of this resolve, the amount that was  
11 refunded to her when she became separated from the  
12 service as aforesaid, and she shall thereupon become  
13 a member of the state retirement system with all the  
14 rights pertaining to such membership, any provisions  
15 of law to the contrary notwithstanding.

16 Upon such redeposit, she may apply for retirement,  
17 and the state retirement board shall accept her appli-  
18 cation, waiving any requirement of prior notice, and

19 consider her application under the provisions of law  
20 for retirement of state employees as provided for in  
21 section seven of chapter thirty-two of the General  
22 Laws as appearing in chapter six hundred and fifty-  
23 eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-five.
