By Mr. Weeks, a petition of William D. Weeks and David L. Flynn for legislation to designate the Vernon Street Bridge over Route 25 in the town of Middleborough as the Private William L. Sukeforth Bridge. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT DESIGNATING THE VERNON STREET BRIDGE OVER ROUTE 25
IN THE TOWN OF MIDDLEBOROUGH AS THE PRIVATE WILLIAM L.
SUKEFORTH BRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Vernon street bridge over state highway route 25 in
2 the town of Middleborough shall be known and designated as
3 the Private William L. Sukeforth bridge, in memory of William
4 L. Sukeforth, who was killed in action while a member of the
5 armed forces of the United States in World War II. A suitable
6 marker bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by
7 the department of public works.
