AN ACT DEFINING THE POWERS OF THE DIVISION OF URBAN AND INDUSTRIAL RENEWAL TO APPROVE LAND ASSEMBLY AND REDEVELOPMENT PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 26KK of chapter 121 of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the words:—
3 and (e) prior to the application for funds from any source, to
4 make a survey, approval of said division had been granted to
5 make such a survey.
