**AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CARE, MAINTENANCE
AND REPAIR OF THE HAMPSHIRE COUNTY HOSPITAL.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Hampshire
2 county are hereby authorized to expend for the year nineteen
3 hundred and seventy-two the sums set forth in this act for the
4 care, maintenance and repair of the county hospital and to assess
5 the same in the manner set forth in section eighty-five of chapter
6 one hundred and eleven of the General Laws.
