

By Mr. Kulik of Worthington, petition of Stephen Kulik and Stanley C. Rosenberg (by vote of the town) for legislation to provide for the appointment of a town clerk-collector-treasurer in the town of South Deerfield. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENT OF TOWN CLERK, COLLECTOR AND TREASURER IN THE TOWN OF SOUTH DEERFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 676 of the acts of 1972 is
2 hereby amended by striking out the second and third sentences
3 and inserting in their place the following three sentences:—

4 Beginning on July 1, 2003 and each July 1 thereafter, the board
5 of selectmen shall appoint a town clerk, tax collector, and trea-
6 surer, who shall serve for a term of one year or until July 1
7 following and until a successor is appointed and qualified, and
8 who shall receive such salary as the town may from time to time
9 determine. The person holding the elected position through
10 June 30, 2003 or until such later time as a successor is appointed
11 or qualified. Upon the appointment and qualification of said town
12 clerk, tax collector, and treasurer in accordance herewith, the term
13 of office of the person holding the elected position of town clerk,
14 tax collector and treasurer shall cease and terminate.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
