AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE TRAINING OF PROFESSIONAL AND SEMI-PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES IN ALL AGENCIES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 7 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 28A the following section:—

3 *Section 28B.* Under the supervision of the commissioner of
4 administration, every agency of the commonwealth shall in-
5 stitute a program for the training of professional and semi-
6 professional employees, subject to rules and regulations made
7 for the purpose by the commission of administration and
8 finance.
