## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE STATUS OF THE CLERK OF THE BOARD OF EXCISE FOR THE CITY OF CHELSEA.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 310 of the special acts of 1916  
2 is hereby amended by striking out the sixth sentence and in-  
3 serting in place thereof the following sentence:—The board  
4 shall appoint an executive secretary who shall keep a record of  
5 all proceedings, issue all notices, attest all such papers and  
6 orders as the board shall direct, and who shall not be subject to  
7 the civil service laws and rules.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
