AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE EMERGENCY FINANCE BOARD TO NOTIFY ITS APPLICANTS WITHIN THIRTY DAYS OF RECEIPT OF REQUEST FOR APPROVAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 49 of the acts of 1933, as amended, is hereby further
- 2 amended by adding the following section: —
- 3 *Section 2A.* Whenever the approval of the board is required
- 4 by special or general law and said approval is sought, the board
- 5 shall notify the petitioner that approval is granted or denied
- 6 within thirty days after the board's receipt of said petition.
