The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO PERFORM OR TO BE PARTY TO THE PERFORMANCE OF AN ABORTION OF A HUMAN FETUS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. That any law to the contrary notwithstanding, it
2 shall be unlawful to be involved in any way with the terminating the
3 life of an unborn fetus or human child at any stage of a pregnancy,
4 (from the moment of conception through the moment of birth).
5 This act to include any consenting parent, participating physician,
6 or any other participant involved.

1 SECTION 2. Such involvement shall be considered as murder
2 in the first degree, and be punishable by death in the electric chair
3 after conviction of a trial by jury.
