By Mr. O'Neill, Jr. of Cambridge, petition of Thomas P. O'Neill, Jr., that superintendents and general foremen of departments of cities and towns be allowed upon reaching the age of retirement to continue for three more years with the consent of the governing board of such municipality. Pensions.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT SUPERINTENDENTS AND GENERAL FOREMEN OF THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITIES AND TOWNS OF THE COMMONWEALTH, UPON REACHING THE AGE OF RETIREMENT BE ALLOWED TO CONTINUE FOR THREE MORE YEARS WITH THE CONSENT OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF SAID CITY OR TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Superintendents and general foremen of the various
2 departments of the cities and towns of the common-
3 wealth, upon reaching the age of retirement, with the
4 consent of the mayor, the appointing officer or board
5 be allowed to continue in the service of the city for
6 three more years.
