RESOLVE

Granting a County Tax for the County of Bristol.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the following sums are hereby appro-
2 priated for the expenses of the county of Bristol for the
3 year nineteen hundred and eleven:—
- 4 For interest on county debt, a sum not exceeding fifty-
5 two thousand two hundred dollars.
- 6 For reduction of county debt, a sum not exceeding
7 forty thousand dollars.
- 8 For salaries of county officers and assistants, fixed by
9 law, a sum not exceeding twenty-five thousand five hun-
10 dred dollars.
- 11 For clerical assistance in county offices, a sum not ex-
12 ceeding sixteen thousand five hundred dollars.
- 13 For salaries and expenses of district and police courts,
14 a sum not exceeding thirty-seven thousand dollars.
- 15 For salaries of jailers, masters and assistants, and sup-
16 port of prisoners in jails and houses of correction, a sum
17 not exceeding ninety-three thousand dollars.
- 18 For criminal costs in the superior court, a sum not ex-
19 ceeding twenty-two thousand dollars.
- 20 For civil expenses in the supreme judicial and su-
21 perior courts, a sum not exceeding twenty-one thousand
22 dollars.

23 For transportation expenses of county and associate
24 commissioners, a sum not exceeding seven hundred dol-
25 lars.

26 For medical examiners, inquests, and commitments of
27 the insane, a sum not exceeding seven thousand five hun-
28 dred dollars.

29 For auditors, masters and referees, a sum not exceed-
30 ing one thousand five hundred dollars.

31 For repairing, furnishing and improving county build-
32 ings, a sum not exceeding fifteen thousand dollars.

33 For fuel, lights and supplies in county buildings, other
34 than jails and houses of correction, and for care of the
35 same, a sum not exceeding thirty-one thousand five hun-
36 dred dollars.

37 For highways, including state highways, bridges and
38 land damages, a sum not exceeding thirteen thousand
39 dollars.

40 For law libraries, a sum not exceeding five thousand
41 dollars.

42 For training school, a sum not exceeding eight thou-
43 sand dollars.

44 For miscellaneous and contingent expenses of the cur-
45 rent year, a sum not exceeding four thousand dollars.

46 And the county commissioners of said county are
47 hereby authorized to levy as the county tax of said county
48 for the current year, in the manner provided by law,
49 the sum of three hundred forty-two thousand four hun-
50 dred dollars, to be expended, together with the cash bal-
51 ance on hand and the receipts from other sources, for
52 the above purposes.
