The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO AIRPORTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 39F of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by chapter 544 of the Acts of 1964, is hereby  
3 amended by deleting the first paragraph and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following: —

5 Whenever any city or town undertakes, in conformity with  
6 the state airport plan, the acquisition, construction, establish-  
7 ment, enlargement, improvement or protection of an airport  
8 and has appropriated sufficient funds, which together with  
9 funds available under this section, shall equal at least twenty-  
10 five per cent of the total cost thereof, the state treasurer, at  
11 the request of the commission, shall pay to or reimburse such  
12 city or town from such funds as have been appropriated for  
13 such purposes, such amount, not exceeding twenty per cent  
14 of the total cost of such work, as may be determined by the  
15 commission.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO HIGHWAYS

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Convention assembled on the twenty-first day of May, A. D. 1924

- 1 Section 106 of chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by changing the chapter 30 of the Act of 1904, in part,
- 3 amended by changing the first paragraph and inserting in lieu
- 4 thereof the following: —
- 5 "Whenever any city or town undertakes to construct or
- 6 to alter any part, the location, extension, widening,
- 7 or maintenance, improvement or purchase of an highway
- 8 and has appropriated money or funds, which together with
- 9 funds available under this act or that exist or hereafter
- 10 for the use of the state and the state treasury, the state treasurer
- 11 the amount of the appropriation shall not be reduced and
- 12 the amount of the appropriation shall not be reduced and
- 13 such purposes shall receive the necessary amounts for each
- 14 of the fiscal year of such work as may be determined by the
- 15 commission.
