AN ACT ESTABLISHING CERTAIN CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR RETIREMENT PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subsection (1) of section 4 of chapter 32 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after paragraph (P) the following paragraph: —
4 (Q) Any member of a retirement system who previously served
5 on the cadet nurse corps of the United States during World War
6 II under the provisions of (57 Stat 153) may establish such service
7 as creditable service by depositing in the annuity savings fund of
8 the system of which he is a member an amount equal to five
9 percent of the compensation received by him during such period
10 of service.
