AN ACT ALLOWING FOR THE CONTRIBUTION OF MONEY BY JUDGES INTO THE JUDGES' RETIREMENT FUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 65D of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amend-
2 ed by adding at the end thereof the following clause (i):

3 (i) Any such judge who has served the commonwealth, or any
4 county, city, town or subdivision thereof as a member of a contrib-
5, utory state pension system shall have the option to credit such
6 service to his judicial service at the rate of one day's credit for each
7 day served in such position; provided that such judge shall deposit
8 in the Judges' Retirement Fund an amount equal to the Retirement
9 Contribution Deduction charged against his or her salary or wages
10 earned during such earlier service together with any interest which
11 would have been earned thereon had the same been deposited with
12 the said Judges' Retirement Fund as of the date of deduction.
