AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Sheriff of the County of Middlesex.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the sheriff of the county of
2 Middlesex shall be three thousand dollars a year, to be
3 so allowed from the first day of January in the year
4 eighteen hundred and ninety-eight.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
