In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

Resolve providing for an Investigation relative to State Assistance to Veterans in acquiring Farms and Homes.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission,
2 to consist of the attorney general, the commis-
3 sioner of agriculture, the commissioner of labor
4 and industries, the commissioner of corporations
5 and taxation, with power in each of said officials
6 to designate and appoint to said commission in
7 his stead a member of his department, and the
8 commissioner of state aid and pensions, is hereby
9 established for the purpose of investigating the
10 subject matter of current house bill numbered
11 two hundred and eighty-eight, providing state
12 assistance to veterans in acquiring farms and
13 homes. The commission may hold public hear-
14 ings and shall be entitled to receive the coopera-
15 tion and assistance of all public officials, boards
16 and commissions. The commission shall report
17 the results of its investigations to the general
18 court by filing its recommendations, together
19 with drafts of legislation to carry such recom-
20 mendations into effect, with the clerk of the
21 senate on or before the first Wednesday of De-
22 cember in the current year.
