## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

### AN ACT REGULATING THE PAYMENT OF CLAIMS UNDER THE PROPERTY PROTECTION INSURANCE LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 34-O of chapter 90 is hereby amended by inserting  
2 after the fourth paragraph the following paragraph: —

3 In any case where the insured is entitled to damages he shall  
4 have the right to require the insurance company to make  
5 payment by check payable to both the insured and the repair  
6 shop where the insured will have his vehicle repaired, provided  
7 the repair shop and the insurer agree on the amount of loss or  
8 damage. The insured shall submit an appraisal of the amount of  
9 damage claims and the name of the repair shop to the insurer.  
10 Any insurer that fails to make payment in accordance with the  
11 provisions of this paragraph shall be punished by a fine of fifty  
12 dollars.
