The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Four.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE TRAINING AND INSTRUCTION IN INDUSTRIAL ARTS FOR CERTAIN STUDENTS AT THE STATE TEACHERS COLLEGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8 of chapter 618 of the acts of 1952 is hereby
2 amended by striking out the last sentence and insert-
3 ing in place thereof the following sentence:— Any-
4 thing in this act to the contrary notwithstanding, the
5 city, acting by its school committee, may, under the
6 auspices of the state department of education but
7 without cost to the commonwealth, provide, so long
8 as said school committee shall elect so to do, for any
9 students at the state teachers college at Boston, such
10 training and instruction in industrial arts, including
11 such facilities therefor, as has heretofore been pro-
12 vided by said city for students at the city's teachers
13 college; provided, however, that the city, acting as
14 aforesaid, shall, under such auspices but without such
15 cost, provide such training and instruction until Sep-
16 tember first, nineteen hundred and fifty-six, for stu-
17 dents who are now, or in September of the current
18 year would be, enrolled in the industrial arts course
19 in the city's teachers college and who become students
20 at the state teacher's college at Boston.
