Said commission may file interim reports, but shall its final report no later than the last Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and eighty-nine.

**Chapter 4. RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF THE WIDOW OF THE LATE ANGELO PICUCCI.**

RESOLVED, That, for the purpose of promoting the public good, and after an appropriation has been made therefor, there be paid out of the state treasury to the widow of the late Angelo Picucci, who died while a member of the present house of representatives, the salary to which he would have been entitled had he lived and served until the end of the term for which he was elected. The additional benefits provided for by this resolve shall be included as regular compensation for Angelo Picucci for the purposes of computing his retirement benefits pursuant to chapter thirty-two of the General Laws.

**Chapter 5. RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT AND NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY EDITIONS OF THE GENERAL LAWS AND FOR MONTHLY PUBLICATION OF AMENDMENTS DURING NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE TO NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-TWO.**

RESOLVED, That counsel to the senate and counsel to the house of representatives be authorized to prepare and contract for publication of new editions of the General Laws which may be referred to as the 1988 Official Edition of the General Laws and 1990 Official Edition of the General Laws. Said editions shall preserve the present chapter and section numbers of the General Laws, and the numbers of inserted chapters and sections, and shall include all amendments and additions to the General Laws enacted on or after January first, nineteen hundred and thirty-two, including those enacted during the session of nineteen hundred and eighty-eight and nineteen hundred and ninety, respectively. Said editions shall include a table of contents, section headings, text of the General Laws, text of the Constitutions of the Commonwealth and the United States and an index. Said counsel shall also be authorized to prepare and contract for monthly publications, and annual Supplements in

General Law format and sequence, of all amendments to the General Laws enacted during the sessions of nineteen hundred and eighty-nine, nineteen hundred and ninety, nineteen hundred and ninety-one and nineteen hundred and ninety-two. Publication of the 1988 Official Edition of the General Laws and of the 1990 Official Edition of the General Laws and said amendments shall be at the risk, expense and profit of the publisher provided that said counsel may contract with the publisher to return a portion of the publication proceeds to the commonwealth and may grant a mutual option to extend the contract to include publication of a 1992 Official Edition of the General Laws and a 1994 Official Edition of the General Laws and monthly publication of amendments to the General Laws and annual Supplements, enacted during the sessions of nineteen hundred and ninety-three, nineteen hundred and ninety-four and nineteen hundred and ninety-five and nineteen hundred and ninety-six. Said counsel is also authorized to contract with the Massachusetts Bar Association to co-sponsor or otherwise promote publication of the General Laws.
