### AN ACT RELATIVE TO LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following new  
3 paragraph:—

4 For the purpose of granting additional licenses under  
5 section fifteen the local licensing authorities of any city or  
6 town, except the city of Boston, may require a greater unit of  
7 estimated population than five thousand or fraction thereof  
8 for each additional license provided that such greater unit  
9 shall not affect an existing license.
